Introduction

IBSSP picks 3 stocks on a weekly basis; 156 over one year.

- expected to be unique under 365 days.
- expected to repeat over 365 days.

The picks are chosen from [ibssp_index](#) (★★★★★, ★★★★★☆, ★★★★★).

- [ibssp_index](#) is a pool of top performing companies.
- performance based on fundamental analysis.

Structure

- (1) the number of stocks that reached intrinsic value.
- (2) the number of stocks that are pending intrinsic value.
- (3) the average number of days that stocks were held.
- (4) the average number of days since the stocks are held.

Strategy

The performance of IBSSP is quantified passively.

- stocks are kept in "[Pending](#)" until intrinsic values are reached.
- or "[Archived](#)" if companies undergo bankruptcy.

Reassessing your stock holdings quarterly, would be recommended.
